Then he put him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him. The next day he took out two denarii, gave them to the innkeeper, and said, 'Take care of him; and when I come back, I will repay you whatever more you spend.' Which of these three, do you think, was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of the robbers?"

He said,

"The one who showed him mercy."

Jesus said to him,

"Go and do likewise."

## 6. "Who is Your Neigh-bor?" Horse Craft

### What you will need:

Paper

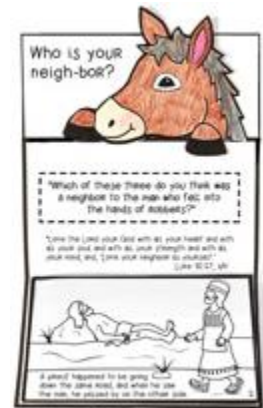
Scissors

Colored Pencils

Glue

### How to make:

1. Print out the patterns.
2. Color the horse picture and then glue it to the top of the cover page.
3. Fold the cover page in half so that the bottom of the page meets just below the line below the horse pattern. The hooves should hang over the line just a little. The hooves will hold the book closed by hanging over the bottom of the page when it is folded.
4. Place the pages of the book in order and then staple them to the bottom of the folded pages where indicated. Staple the pages on the left-hand side of the page.

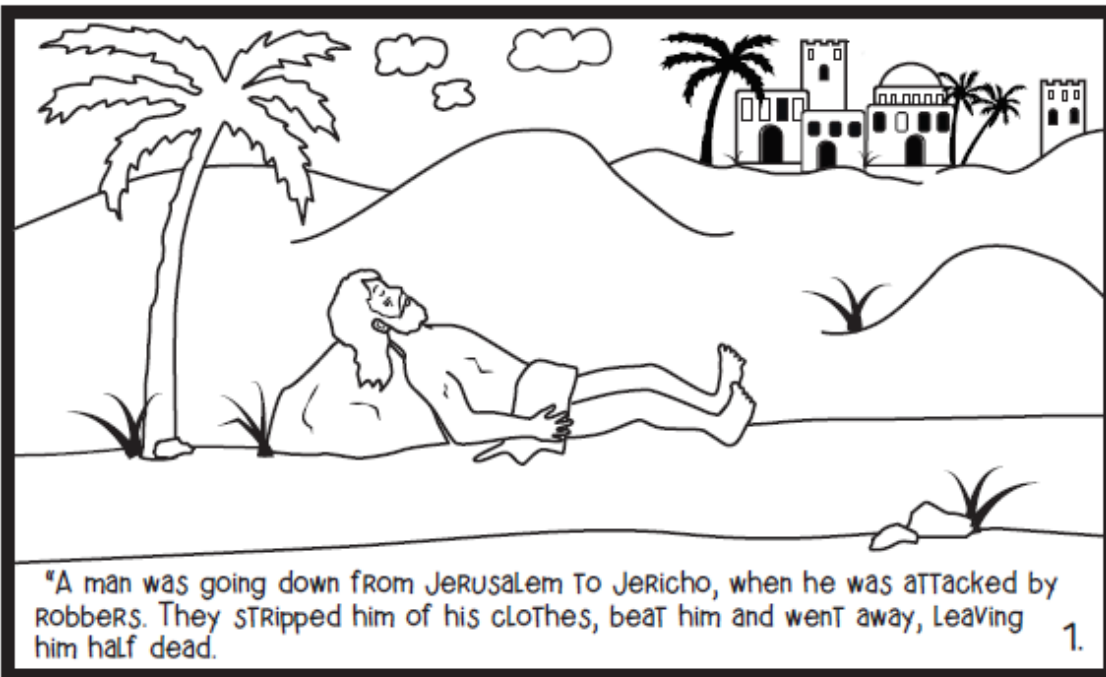
