Now there was an Ethiopian eunuch, a court official of the Candace,  of the Ethiopians, in charge of her entire . He had come to Jerusalem to worship ²⁸ and was returning home; seated in his  he was reading the prophet Isaiah. ²⁹ Then the Spirit said to Philip, "Go over to this  and join it." ³⁰ So Philip  up to it and  him  the prophet Isaiah.






He asked, "Do you understand what you are reading?" ³¹ He replied, "How can I, unless someone guides me?" And he invited Philip to get in and  beside him. ³² Now the passage of the scripture that he was reading was this:

"Like a sheep he was led to the slaughter,
and like a lamb silent before its shearer,
so he does not open his mouth.

³³ In his humiliation justice was denied him.
Who can describe his generation?
For his life is taken away from the earth."

³⁴ The eunuch asked Philip, "About whom, may I ask you, does the prophet say this, about himself or about someone else?" ³⁵ Then Philip began to speak, and starting with this scripture, he proclaimed to him the good news about Jesus.

³⁶ As they were going along the road, they came to some ; and the eunuch said,

"Look, here is ! What is to prevent me from being baptized?" ³⁸ He commanded the  to stop, and both of them, Philip and the eunuch, went  into the  and Philip baptized him. ³⁹ When they came  out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord snatched Philip away; the eunuch saw him no more, and went on his way rejoicing.

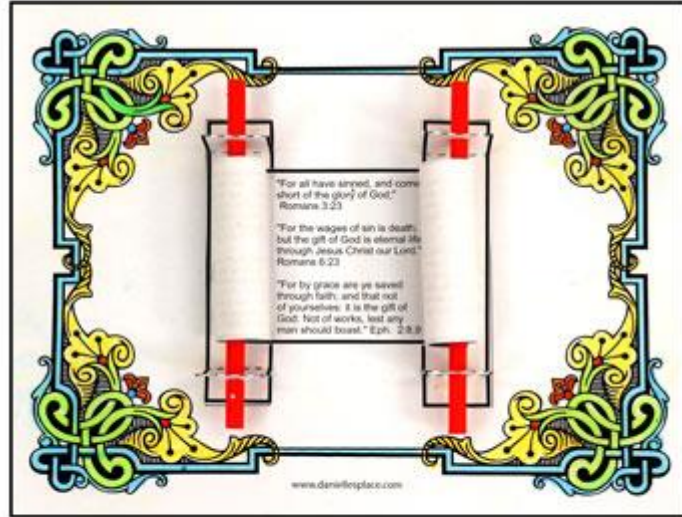

Children TURN THE STRAW handles TO REVEAL THE VERSES.

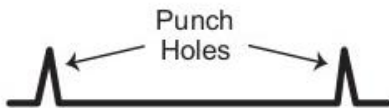

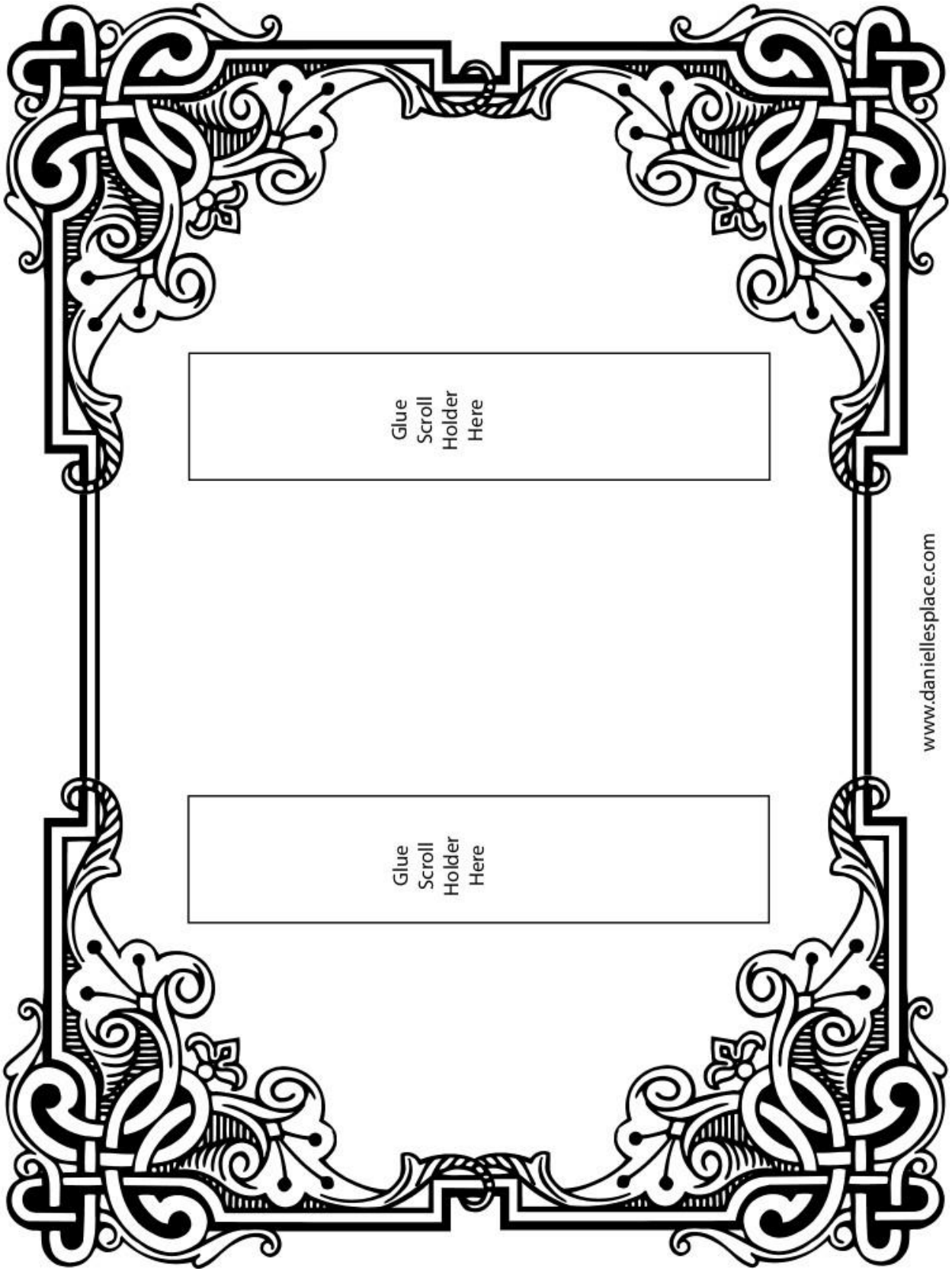
Find two stir sticks or straws or twigs and put them through the holes in the holders. Tape the ends of your scroll to the straws and roll it open and closed to read the message.
