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## John 7:37 - 52 NRSV

### Rivers of Living Water

**37** On the last day of the festival, the great day, while Jesus was standing there, he cried out, “Let anyone who is thirsty come to me, **38** and let the one who believes in me drink. As<sup>[a]</sup> the scripture has said, ‘Out of the believer’s heart<sup>[b]</sup> shall flow rivers of living water.’” **39** Now he said this about the Spirit, which believers in him were to receive; for as yet there was no Spirit,<sup>[c]</sup> because Jesus was not yet glorified.

### Division among the People

**40** When they heard these words, some in the crowd said, “This is really the prophet.” **41** Others said, “This is the Messiah.”<sup>[d]</sup> But some asked, “Surely the Messiah<sup>[e]</sup> does not come from Galilee, does he? **42** Has not the scripture said that the Messiah<sup>[f]</sup> is descended from David and comes from Bethlehem, the village where David lived?” **43** So there was a division in the crowd because of him. **44** Some of them wanted to arrest him, but no one laid hands on him.

### The Unbelief of Those in Authority

**45** Then the temple police went back to the chief priests and Pharisees, who asked them, “Why did you not arrest him?” **46** The police answered, “Never has anyone spoken like this!” **47** Then the Pharisees replied, “Surely you have not been deceived too, have you? **48** Has any one of the authorities or of the Pharisees believed in him? **49** But this crowd, which does not know the law—they are accursed.” **50** Nicodemus, who had gone to Jesus<sup>[g]</sup> before, and who was one of them, asked, **51** “Our law does not judge people without first giving them a hearing to find out what they are doing, does it?” **52** They replied, “Surely you are not also from Galilee, are you? Search and you will see that no prophet is to arise from Galilee.”

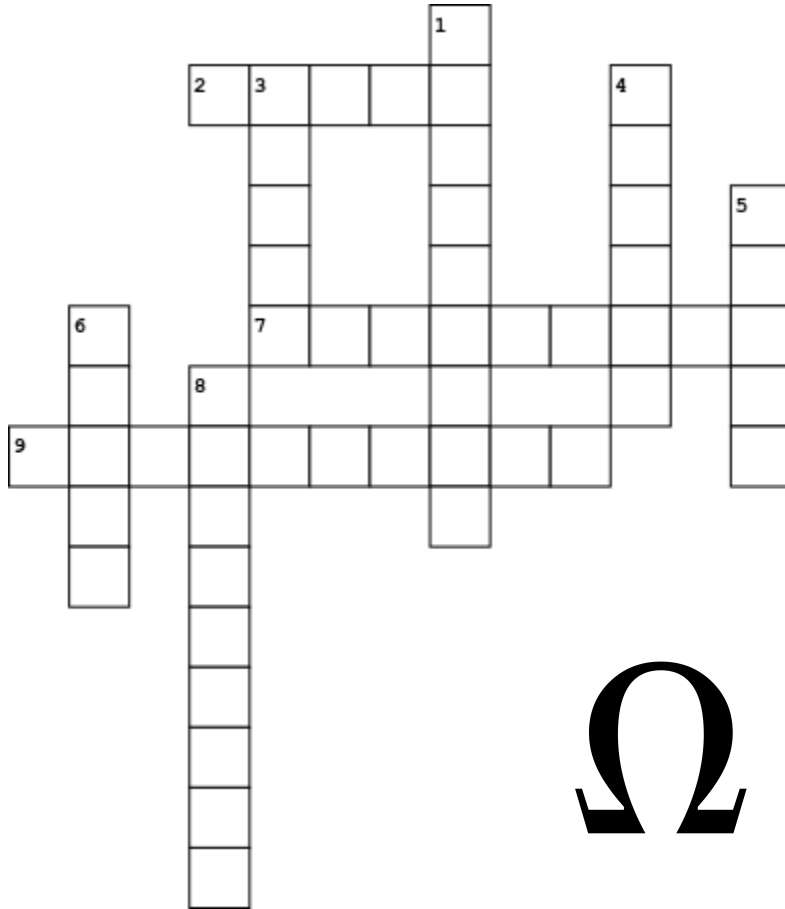

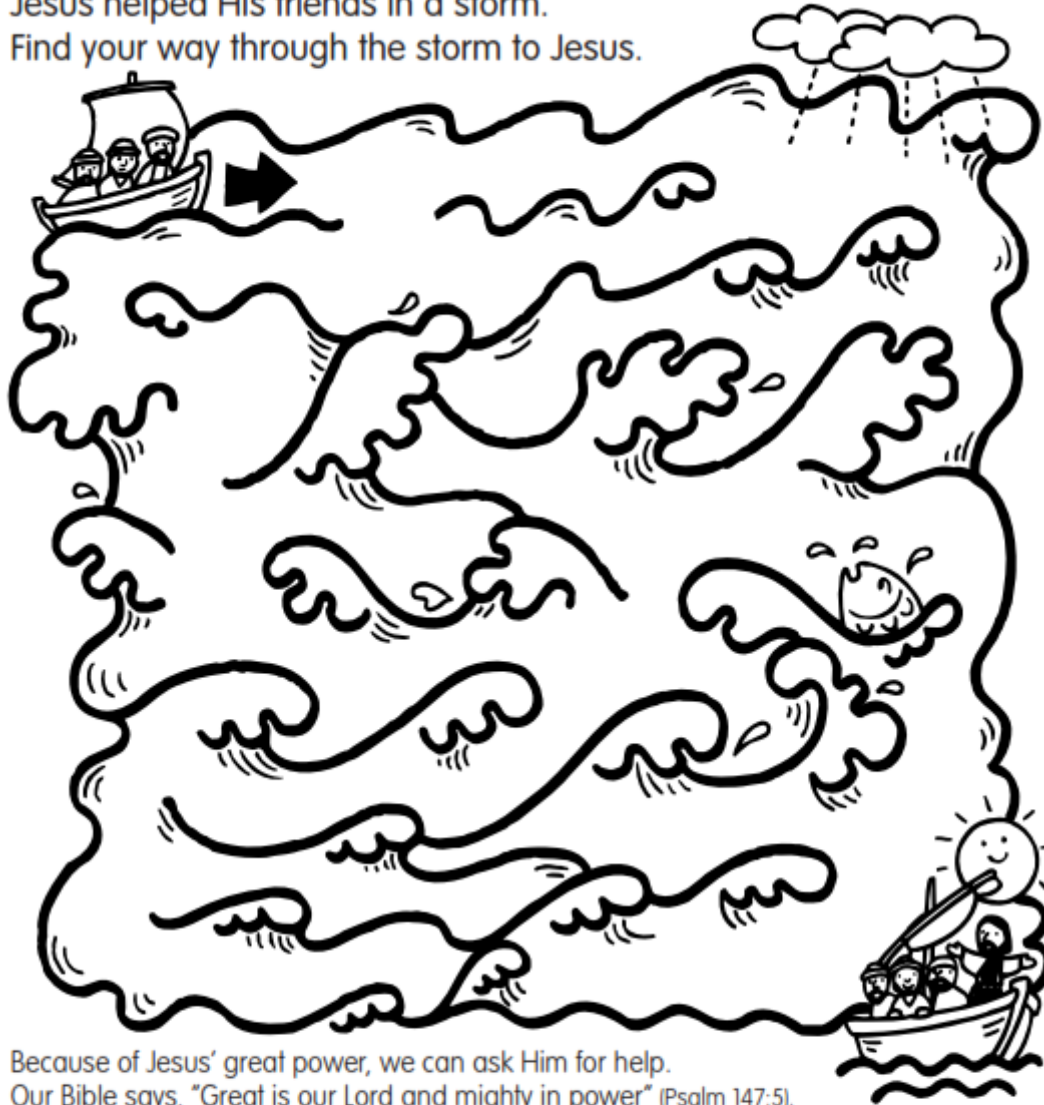

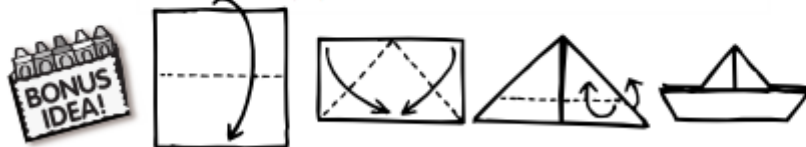
