and hold fast my covenant-


**7** these I will bring to my holy mountain and make them joyful in my house of prayer;

their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be accepted on my altar,


for my house shall be called a house of prayer

8 Thus says the Lord God, who gathers the outcasts of Israel:I will gather others to them besides those already gathered.








# KNOWN AS A HOUSE OF PRAYER




