They wanted to praise God.

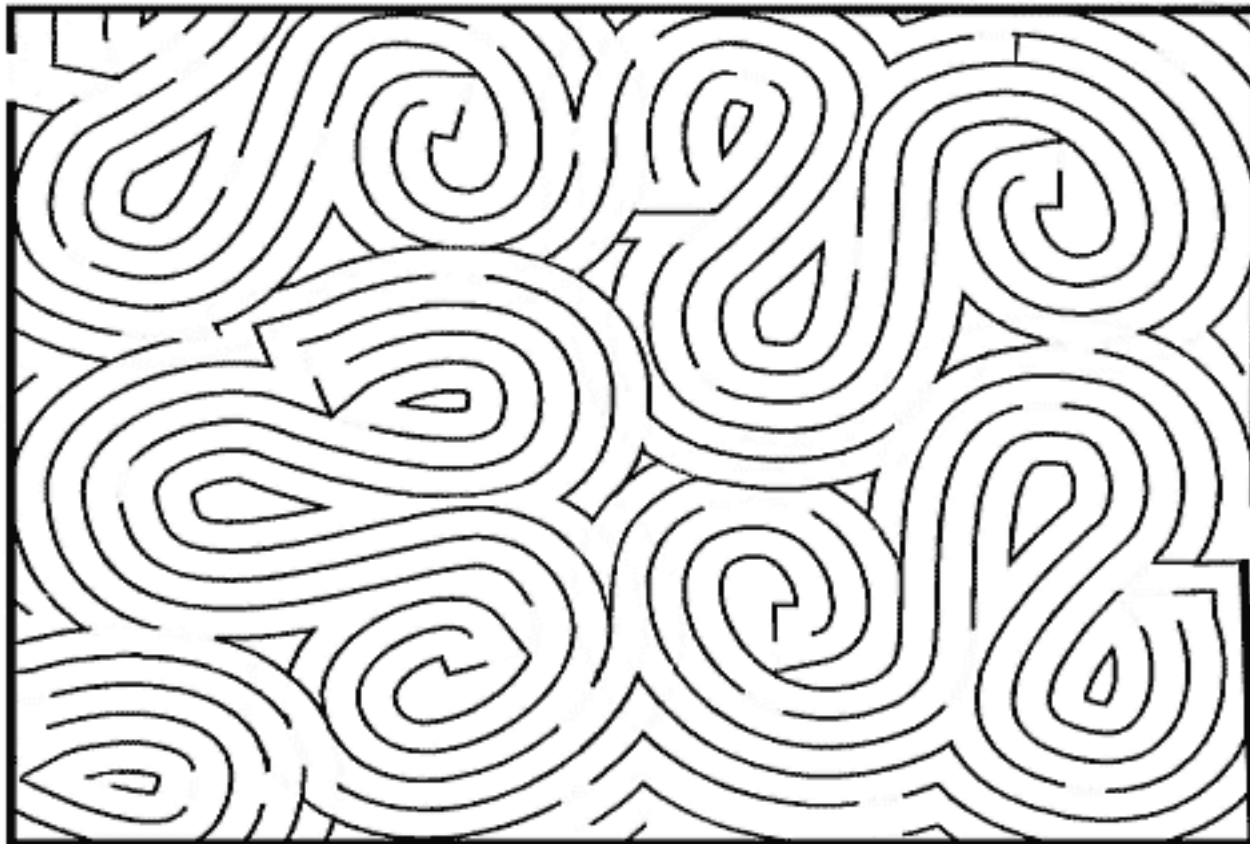
Moses and all the people began to sing a song to God.

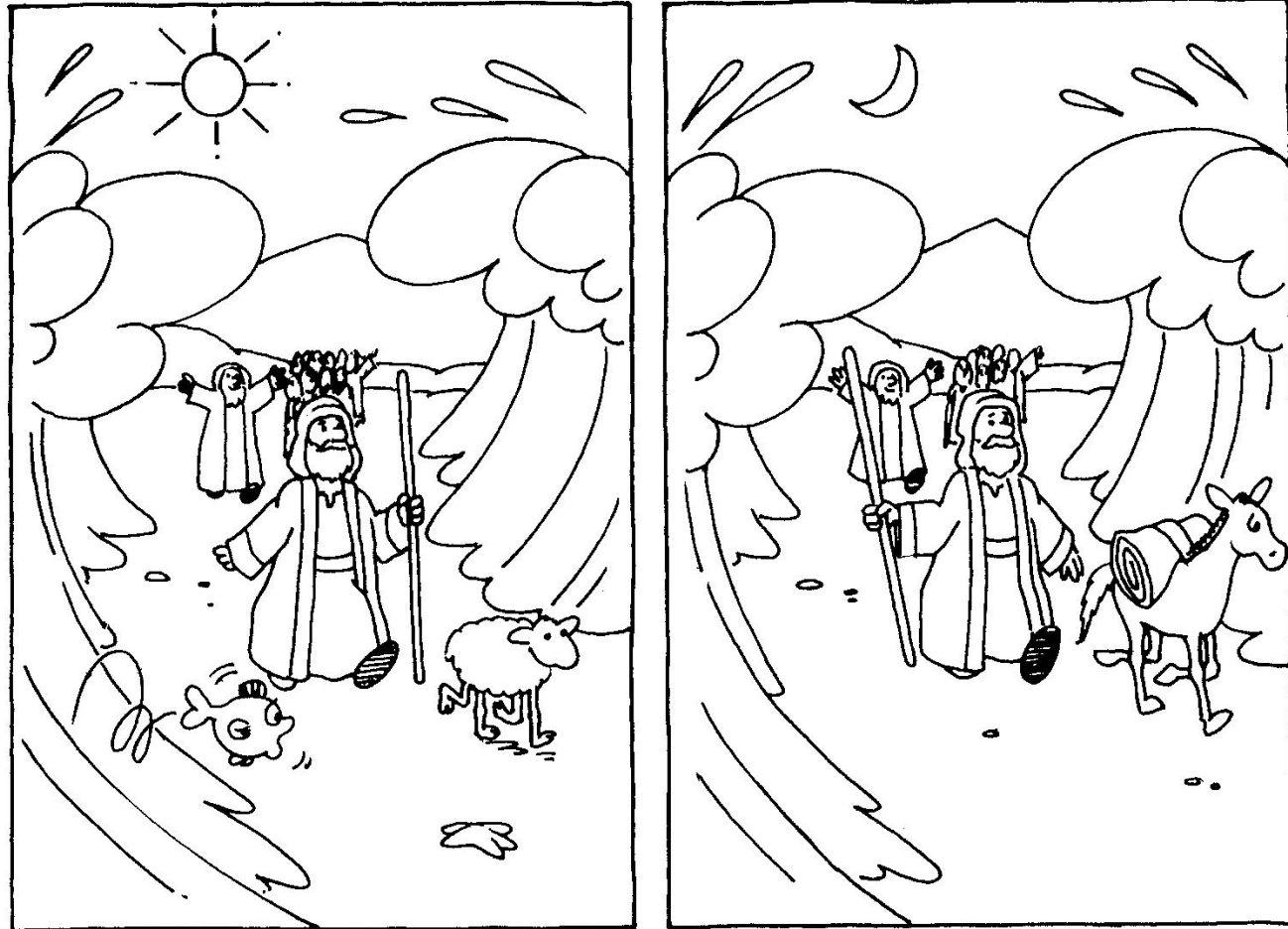
