### Theme of the day:

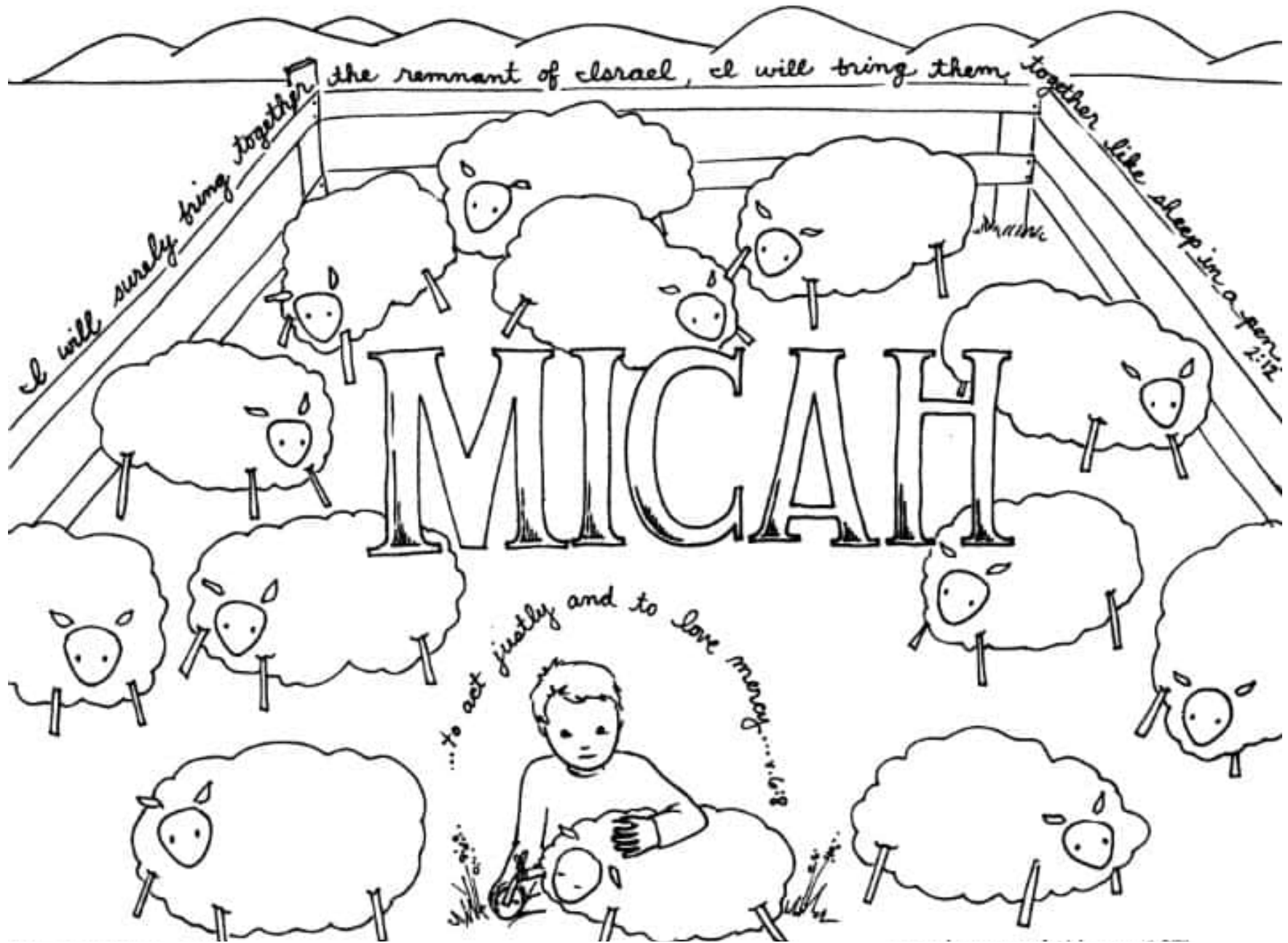

## comfort the sorrowful

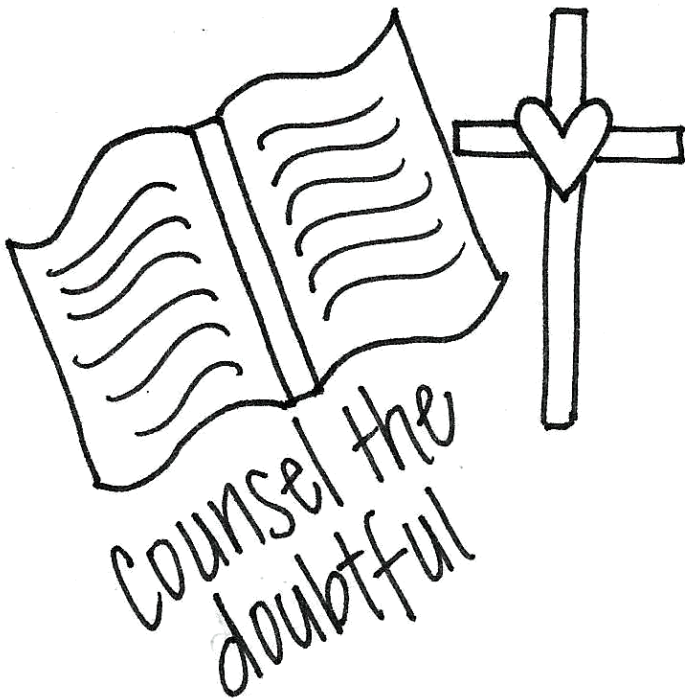

## instruct the ignorant

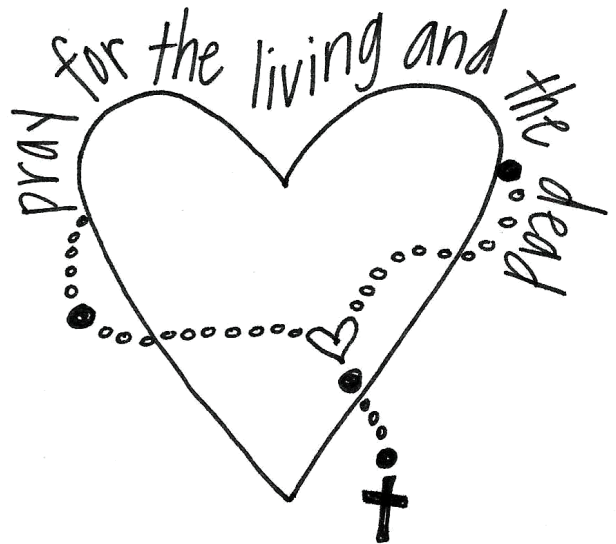
